**SCHOOL DEVOTION** The next joint devotion with Pastor will be **Friday**, **April 5**. The students will receive envelopes that may be used for a thankoffering.

Our thankoffering mission project this year is our Wisconsin Ev. Lutheran Synod's mission effort in Vietnam. The Lord has provided an opportunity for our church body to build a theological training center in Hanoi, the capitol of Vietnam. Ours is the first Christian group permitted by the still-Communist government of Vietnam to build a facility directly related to work with the Gospel of Christ! Our synod hopes to receive \$2 million dollars by Easter 2019 for this effort.

<u>PASTOR CHARTRAND</u>, from the Recruiting Department at Michigan Lutheran Seminary (MLS) in Saginaw, will make a presentation to our  $1^{st} - 5^{th}$  grade students about life at MLS and the purpose of that school. We look forward to Pastor Chartrand's visit!

**SPECIAL LETTER** Since only half of our Preschool and K-5 families responded to the February letter about a tuition increase to support an upper grades teacher, our congregation's Board of Christian Education is distributing the letter again.

We urge <u>every family</u> to respond so the board can determine if there is sufficient financial support to add a faculty member.

Pastor Voss is preparing a cover letter to go with the letter submitted last month. He will update the dates listed in the letter, then distribute the letter personally to each family this Friday morning and afternoon. We ask that you submit your response to Pastor Voss by <u>next Friday, March 15</u>. Pastor Voss will not reveal the amount that any family indicates on the form. Instead, he will report to the board the total financial commitment expressed by all our families on their respective forms.

Our Board of Christian Education <u>urges each family</u> to submit a response so that the board can make an informed, accurate recommendation about adding upper grades.
