GENERAL INFORMATION

<u>CHRISTMAS DEVOTION</u> Next Friday, December 21 we will have an Advent / Christmas devotion with our entire student body, faculty, and any parents who are at school at 8:35. We will focus on the real Christmas: why it's necessary, who it involves, what it means, and where it takes us. *We won't distribute envelopes for a thankoffering. But some of the students still have theirs from earlier this month and are encouraged to use them next Friday.*

This school year our once-a-month thankofferings are going to our Wisconsin Synod's World Missions for use in Vietnam, where the Lord of the Church has opened for us a door to bring His saving message of salvation by His grace alone, through faith in Him alone, as revealed in Holy Scripture alone.

SINGING FOR WORSHIP Students in K-5 will sing at the beginning of our 10:30 worship service **Sunday**, **December 16.** And then Preschool – Grade 5 (along with our Sunday School students through eighth grade) will sing and proclaim about our newborn Savior in the Christmas Eve service at 7:00 **December 24**.

<u>CHRISTMAS EVE SERVICE AT MEMORIAL EV. LUTHERAN CHURCH</u> The children who will be participating in the Christmas Eve worship service will gather at church on *Saturdays, December 15 and 22* from 9:30 – 11:30 those two Saturday mornings to practice their parts for the service.

Parents, for the children are to proclaim God's Word on Christmas Eve in word and song effectively, their attendance at these rehearsals are very important. Please plan now to have your children here those two mornings. If your child must miss a rehearsal, please speak with Pastor Voss ahead of time.

If travel plans will keep your child from being here Christmas Eve, please mention it to Pastor Voss as soon as you are aware of the conflict so that the necessary changes can be made in service assignments.

Our Sunday School staff will host a lunch for the children participating in the service and their families after the December 15 rehearsal. The lunch will be ready at <u>11:30</u> that morning.

The children should be in the church fellowship hall by 6:40 on Christmas Eve. Have you tried on those Christmas clothes? We ask that children wear nice church clothes for the service and we know how fast they grow.

A very important consideration is whether or not the parents of our current students would enroll their 6^{th} grade children at Memorial should we offer 6^{th} grade instruction, as well as what kind of tuition parents would be able to pay for such instruction.
