#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

<u>MISSION THANKOFFERINGS</u> are gathered at our combined devotion each month. The devotions will usually be held the *first Thursday of each month*. We held the October devotion today.

The thankofferings collected this school year will be sent to *Martin Luther College* (MLC) in New Ulm, Minnesota. The faculty of MLC that trains those who will serve as pastors and teachers who in churches and school of Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod (WELS).

Teacher-track students who graduate from MLC are assigned to WELS schools to begin their work instructing our Savior's lambs. Mrs. Domke and Mrs. Leitz both graduated from the college. Pastor-track students who graduate from MLC continue their studies for four more years at Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary in Mequon, Wisconsin.

Envelopes are provided for the children to use at these devotions. The next one is scheduled for *Thursday*, *November 7* (though we might move it up to October 31).

**OPPORTUNITY TO SING** This Sunday our students in grades k-5 will sing at the beginning of the 10:30 worship service. They will gather together in our fellowship hall after Sunday School to practice.

**HOT LUNCH** will next be served *Friday*, *October 18*. We thank Mrs. Labadie for organizing the meal and purchasing some of the food for it. We also thank the Chaffee family for their donation of meat for Friday's meal. The menu will be: a taco bar, fruit, punch, water and dessert.

Mrs. Leitz is now working with the company to place the order and to arrange for shipping.
